IMPORTANT

1. CANDIDATES TO ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE POSTS: The candidates applying for the post(s) should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions at the time of submission of application. Their admission at all stages of the recruitment will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. Mere issue of call letter to the candidate will not imply that his/her candidature has been finally cleared by the Recruitment Board. RRBs shall verify the eligibility conditions with reference to original documents only at the time of Certificate Verification.

2. CANDIDATES SHOULD APPLY ONLY TO ONE RRB FOR ONE POST: A candidate shall apply against the vacancies of only one RRB for a particular category of post. Applying to more than one RRB for the same post is not allowed. Application of a candidate to more than one RRB for the same post is liable to be rejected. The candidate shall, however, be free to apply to more than one RRB in case he/she wishes to apply for more than one category of post. Candidates applying to more than one RRB for different posts will be doing so at their own risk as examination for more than one category of posts may be held simultaneously **'based on administrative convenience'**

3. APPLICATION FORM : The format of application form and information sheet is given at **Annexure 2 and 3**. These forms can be neatly typed or photocopied on a A4 size 80GSM bond paper. It can also be downloaded from respective RRB websites and also from **www.railwayrecruitment.org**

4. PROFORMA OF CASTE CERTIFICATES : The candidates are required to obtain caste certificates in the proper pro-forma from the competent Authority and produce the same at the time of verification failing which he/she may be disqualified. **Please refer to Annexure-4, 5 & 6**

5. DETAILS OF RRB OFFICES: Refer to Annexure-1

6. RECRUITMENT AGAINST QUOTA EARMARKED FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWD) : Suitability of posts identified for persons with Disabilities is indicated in column No.11 against each post. Kindly note that these are only indicative in nature and the final authority for deciding the suitability of post (s) for PWD rests with the Chief Personnel Officer of the Zonal Railway/Production Unit concerned. **The RRBs will not be filling up the vacancies for PWD. These post(s) if reserved and identified as suitable for PWD by the respective Zonal Railways/Production Units, will be filled up by the concerned Chief Personnel Officer directly.**

7. Proof of educational/Technical qualification and date of birth is not required to be submitted along with application. However, attested copies of certificates for the proof of caste for SC, ST & OBC candidates and discharge certificate in respect of EXS candidates are required to be attached.

8. RRBs will not be responsible for postal delay or wrong delivery, if any, for any correspondence at any stage of selection.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. SALARY AND OTHER EMOLUMENTS

- 1.1 During the period of Training: For certain category of post(s), selected candidates have to undergo successful training for specified period, as indicated against such post(s). During the period of training, selected candidates would be paid stipend. For certain categories, candidates will be required to pay security deposit as per extant rules.
- 1.2 On Joining: The monthly emoluments on joining or after successful completion of training, wherever prescribed, will be in the minimum of the scale of pay plus Dearness Allowance and other allowances as applicable.

2. MODE OF SELECTION

- 2.1 The selection will be made on the basis of Written Examination(s) 'Certificate verification' and Interviews wherever necessary will also be conducted. Merely satisfying the educational qualification and the age prescribed itself will not constitute a right to be called for the Written Examination unless the candidate fulfills other conditions/requirements mentioned in the Employment Notice.
- 2.2 Selection procedure for each category is given in Column 15. Candidates will have to qualify in all the examination(s)/test(s) prescribed for the category for which they have applied.
- 2.3 There will be NEGATIVE MARKING. 1/3 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- 2.4 The Railway Recruitment Board concerned at its discretion may hold additional written test, skill test or Interview(s) if considered necessary for all or for a limited number of candidates as may be deemed fit by the Railway Recruitment Board.
- 2.5 **Syllabus for Written Examination:** The syllabus for the written examination will generally be in conformity with the educational standards prescribed for the post. Written examination will consist mainly of objective type questions to test the candidates General Knowledge, analytical and quantitative skills and knowledge in the subjects specified as part of minimum educational qualification for the post.
- 2.6 Normally, call letters for the written examination(s) are sent one month before the date of examination Date(s) of written examination are notified by the RRBs in the Employment News/Rozgar Samachar and/or leading newspapers and/or displayed in the RRB website. Candidates who do not get the call letter for the examination, can approach the RRB concerned for issue of duplicate call letters.
- 2.7 Examinations are conducted, based on the number of applications received, at important centres within the geographical jurisdiction of the RRB concerned. Under no circumstances, request for change of examination centre, date and time of exam will be entertained.
- 2.8 Admission to the examination centre is provisional. In case a candidate does not fulfill the entire requirement prescribed in the Employment Notice, his/her candidature is liable to be rejected at any stage, when deficiency is noticed. Mere issue of call letter for appearing in written exam by RRB does not confer any right for any subsequent stage of recruitment process or placing his/her name on the panel.
- 2.9 Depending upon the number of vacancies, candidates who qualify in the written examination and satisfy the eligibility criteria upto the required number, will be advised regarding further selection. Results of the examinations are also notified by the RRBs in the Employment News/Rozgar Samachar and/or leading news papers and/or displayed in the RRB website.
- 2.10 Panels will be formed only after verification of original certificates for proof of age, educational/technical qualification, community etc. of the successful candidates for which they will have to present themselves on the date fixed by the RRB.
- 2.11 Selected candidates will have to successfully complete medical examination of the prescribed standard before joining service.
- 2.12 Free Pass: Free second class pass will be issued to the candidates who belong to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe communities when they are called for written examination or for interview/verification. SC/ST candidates should, therefore, ensure that the nearest Railway Station is clearly mentioned in the relevant column of the application form. All other candidates called for have to appear at their own cost.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT

- (i) Candidates must fill in the application and information sheet form in their own handwriting only.
- (ii) Before starting to fill in these application forms, read carefully the complete notification and ensure that he/she is eligible in all respects for applying to the posts.
- (iii) Those awaiting results/qualifying certificates of their final examination need not apply. The candidates should have the requisite academic and technical qualification from a recognized University/ Institution for the post applied for at the time of application itself and candidates acquiring such qualification after the date of application shall not be considered eligible.
- (iv) Candidate should send only one application for a post.
- (v) A candidate shall apply against the vacancies of only one RRB for a particular category of post. Applying to more than one RRB for the same post is not allowed. Application of a candidate to more than one RRB for the same post is liable to be rejected.
- (vi) The candidate shall, however, be free to apply to more than one RRB in case he/she wishes to apply for more than one category of post. Candidates applying to more than one RRB for different posts will be doing so at their own risk as examination for more than one category of posts may be held simultaneously.
- (vii) RRB reserves the right to reject the candidature of any applicant at any stage of recruitment process if the candidate is found ineligible for the post for which he/she has applied or indulges in any form of malpractice. Services of such ineligible candidates are also liable to be terminated even if appointed inadvertently.
- (viii) The number of vacancies given in the statement is provisional and is liable to vary at the time of final selection.
- (ix) Various information, data, terms and conditions mentioned in the Employment Notice are liable to change due to Government or Judicial Order made subsequently. Also, any subsequent changes in the terms and conditions of this Employment Notice as per extant rules will stand good.
- (x) Candidates who have been debarred from all RRB examinations for life or those who have been debarred for a specific period, are not eligible to apply if the period of debarment of such candidates is not completed.
- (xi) Male and female candidates both are eligible to apply for all posts. Female candidates may however note that the nature of duties may involve outdoor/shift duties.
- (xii) Candidates trying to use influence or unfair means will be disqualified from selection.

4. ALLOTMENT

- 4.1 The selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in the Zonal Railway/Production Unit mentioned in Column No.4.
- 4.2 The seniority among the incumbents of a post in a grade is governed by the date of appointment to the grade in the unit of seniority subject to maintenance of interse seniority of the combined merit order assigned by the RRB. Direct recruits for initial training to Training Schools will rank in the seniority in the end of training period before being posted to working post.

5. AGE

- 5.1 The lower and upper age limits applicable for the post are indicated in Column No. 12. The age will be reckoned as on 01.07.2006. The upper age is relaxable as under subject to the production of requisite certificate.
- 5.2 For the purpose of determining the age, the date of birth recorded in the Matric/Secondary School Certificate issued by the Board or School leaving certificate countersigned by Inspector of Schools/District Education Office/or equivalent will be taken.
- 5.3 Candidates should ensure that he/she has the requisite age prescribed for the post before applying. They are not required to enclose proof of age along with the application. However, the original certificates would be verified at the time of 'Certificate verification' and any concealment of fact or discrepancy or error detected at that stage or at any other stage will make the candidate liable for disqualification. The decision of the RRB in this regard shall be final and binding on the candidate.

5(a) SPECIAL AGE RELAXATION

- 5(a)1. Special age relaxation is available to some groups of candidates as indicated below. Candidates desirous of availing age relaxation should indicate the corresponding code in the application form in the space provided. Such candidates will have to submit valid certificates issued by the competent authority as in annexure 4 & 5.

Age relaxation in other cases may also be considered as per the instruction issued by the Central Government from time to time.

- 5(a)2. No age relaxation is allowed to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying against Unreserved posts. Even if they qualify for such posts where only UR vacancies exist, they will be rejected on age grounds if they do not fulfill the UR age criteria. In the same way if SC/ST/OBC candidates qualify in the UR merit list but they do not fulfill the UR age criteria, they will be adjusted against their respective quota vacancies, if available.

6. OBC CANDIDATES

- 6.1 OBC candidates should specifically obtain a certificate to the effect that the candidate does not belong to creamy layer. Unless this criteria is satisfied, OBC candidates cannot avail of the reservation under this quota and if they have indicated the community as OBC, their application will be rejected and they will not be considered even against unreserved quota.
- 6.2 The OBC Certificate should be current (please refer to the prescribed format shown as Annexure 5)
- 6.3 OBC candidates are also required to fill a separate declaration as mentioned at Annexure 6.

7. EX-SERVICEMEN CANDIDATES

- 7.1 Ex-servicemen candidates are permitted to apply against the advertised vacancies for which they will be granted age relaxation and fee exemption.
- 7.2 The term ex-serviceman means a person who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or as non-combatant) in the regular Army, Navy or Air Force of the Indian Union but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the General Reserve Engineering Force, the Lok Sahayak Sena and the Para Military Forces; and (i) who has retired from such service after earning his/her pension or (ii) who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded military service or other disability pension or (iii) who has been released otherwise than on his own request as a result of reduction in such establishment or (iv) who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories: (a) Pension holders for continuous embodied service, (b) Pensions with disabilities attributable to military service and (c) Gallantry Award Winners. Explanation: The persons serving in the armed forces of the Union, who on retirement from service, would come under the category of Ex-serviceman, are permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specific terms of the engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to the Ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specified terms of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union.
- 7.3 Ex-serviceman candidates who have already secured employment under the Central Government in Group C/D will be permitted the benefit of age relaxation as prescribed for Ex-servicemen for securing another employment in a higher grade or cadre in Group C/D under Central Government. However, such candidates will not be considered under ex-servicemen quota in Central Government jobs.

- 7.4 Matriculate ex-serviceman with 15 years of active service in Armed Forces will be considered eligible to apply for the posts for which minimum qualification is a University Degree, provided the relevant certificate issued by the Military authorities is attached with the application.

8. EDUCATIONAL/PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- 8.1 Candidates should carefully go through the eligibility criteria for the post applied for and ensure that he/she meets all the conditions therein. A candidate must possess the requisite qualification for the post applied for at the time of application itself and candidates acquiring such qualification after the last date of application shall not be considered eligible.
- 8.2 Certificates issued by the appropriate Board or University would only be considered. Certificates issued by the Head of the Institution would not be entertained.
- 8.3 Candidates are not required to attach proof of educational qualification with their application. However, the original certificates would be verified at the time of 'Certificate verification' and any concealment of fact or discrepancy or error detected at that stage or at any other stage will make the candidate liable for disqualification. The decision of the RRB in this regard shall be final and binding on the candidate.

9. SERVING EMPLOYEES

- 9.1 A candidate serving under any Government or Public Sector Enterprise/Undertaking, including Railways, can send an advance copy of the application complete in all respects including enclosures within the notice period and their applications sent through proper channel should follow at the earliest. Such candidates can send their application directly to RRB enclosing a "No Objection Certificate" issued by the employer.

10. TERRITORIAL ARMY

- 10.1 All male candidates appointed are liable for active Territorial Army Service in Railway Engineering Units for such periods as laid down from time to time.

11. MEDICAL STANDARDS

- 11.1 Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass requisite medical fitness test(s) conducted by the Railway Administration to ensure that the candidates are medically fit to carry out the duties connected with the post.
- 11.2 Medical standard applicable for the post are mentioned in Column No. 13.
- 11.3 Some of the Medical standards for different categories are given below:-
 - A-1 Physically fit in all respects. Visual standards Distance vision: 6/6, 6/6 without glasses. Near vision: Sn. 0.6, 0.6 without glasses (must clear Fogging Test). Colour vision, Binocular vision, Field of vision and Night vision must be present.
 - A-2 Physically fit in all respects. Visual standards Distance vision: 6/9, 6/9 without glasses. Near vision: Sn. 0.6, 0.6 without glasses. Colour vision, Binocular vision, Field of vision and Night vision must be present.
 - A-3 Physically fit in all respects. Visual standards Distance vision: 6/9, 6/9 without glasses. (Power not to exceed +/- 2D) Near vision: Sn. 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required. Colour vision, Binocular vision, Field of vision and Night vision must be present.
 - B-1 Physically fit in all respects. Visual standards Distance vision: 6/9, 6/12 with or without glasses (Power not to exceed +/- 4D). Near vision: Sn. 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required. Colour vision, Binocular vision, Field of vision and Night vision must be present.
 - B-2 Physically fit in all respects. Visual standards Distance vision: 6/9, 6/12 with or without glasses. (Power not to exceed +/- 4D) Near vision: Sn. 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required. Binocular vision must be present.
 - C-1 Physically fit in all respects. Visual standards Distance vision: 6/12, 6/18 with or without glasses. Near vision: Sn.0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required.
 - C-2 Physically fit in all respects. Visual standards Distance vision: 6/12, Nil with or without glasses. Near vision: Sn. 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required.
- 11.4 Details and criteria given above are indicative and not exhaustive. Other tests, as required, will also be included.
- 11.5 Candidates who do not fulfill the prescribed medical standards need not apply.

12. EXAMINATION FEE

- 12.1 For SC/ST/Ex-serviceman candidates no fee is required.
- 12.2 For OBC and UR candidates, examination fee is Rs. 40/- for posts carrying a scale of pay up to Rs. 3050-4590 and Rs. 60/- for categories of posts with higher scale of pay. The RRB-wise break-up of fee payable for each category and the details regarding IPOs/DDs to be 'drawn in favour' and also 'payable at' are given at Annexure-I.
- 12.3 The fees are payable either in the form of 'Demand Drafts (DDs)' issued by Banks or 'Indian Postal Orders (IPOs)' issued by Postal authorities. DDs should have minimum validity of 6 months.
- 12.4 DDs and IPOs issued before the date of issue of this Employment Notice or after the closing date will not be accepted and the application form will not be considered and rejected.
- 12.5 The candidates should write his/her full name, address and category number of the post on the reverse of the DDs and IPOs. Details of DDs/IPOs should be indicated on the space provided for in the application.
- 12.6 The examination fee is not refundable/transferable/adjustable under any circumstances.
- 12.7 Applications received with Cash/Cheque/Central Recruitment Fee Stamps and Money Orders will not be accepted and will be REJECTED.

13. PHOTOGRAPH

- 13.1 One latest and clear photograph (not more than one month old) of size 4 cm x 5 cm should be pasted on the application in the space provided for. Candidates are also required to attach one additional copy of photograph with their application. Photocopies of the photos will not be accepted.

14. HOW TO APPLY

- 14.1 Application form consists of two sheets, (a) Application Form and (b) Information Sheet. Both should be in conformity to A4 size as per Employment Notice on a good quality (80 GSM Bond paper) white plain foolscap paper.
- 14.2 The application form and annexures may be taken from the Employment Notice or may be downloaded from the RRB web sites.
- 14.3 Candidates purchasing the printed application form from the market/private agencies/individuals should ensure that the application form and annexures should conform to A4 size printed on a good quality white paper and should be exact replica of prescribed forms.
- 14.4 The Application Form and Information Sheet should be filled in candidate's own handwriting, strictly observing the instructions given in the Employment Notice on either in English or Hindi language on one side of the paper and should be dated and signed.
- 14.5 CANDIDATES ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO WRITE THE DECLARATION IN PARA 10 OF THE INFORMATION DATASHEET IN THEIR OWN HANDWRITING AND SIGN.

- 14.6 Signatures of the applicant must be specific so that same may not be copied easily. Signatures in CAPITAL LETTERS or OPEN LETTERS will not be accepted and the applications having such type of signatures will be outrightly rejected.
- 14.7 Affixing the Left Thumb Impression in the Application Form is compulsory. The Left Thumb Impression should be clear and not smuggled or blotted.
- 14.8 The Application Form and Information Sheet complete in all respects along with enclosures, as applicable in Para 15 below, should be securely tagged. The envelope containing the application should be superscribed "Application for the post of _____ Category No. _____" and community should be clearly indicated on the envelope, i.e., SC/ST/OBC/UR/Ex-Servicemen
- 14.9 Applications should be sent by ORDINARY POST ONLY to the respective RRBs or dropped at the box kept at their office(s) on or before the closing date. Under no circumstances applications received after the closing date and time will be entertained. Applications sent by Registered Post, Courier or Speed Post will not be acknowledged.
- 14.10 Details regarding to whom the applications are to be addressed for each RRB, their postal addresses, fee payable for the posts and DDs/IPOs to be drawn in favour of etc., are given in the Annexure-I.

15. ENCLOSURES

The following enclosures should be firmly attached along with the completed Application Form & Personal Data Sheet.

- A valid Indian Postal Order or Demand Draft of the prescribed value (applicable only for OBC and UR candidates).
- Attested copy of Caste Certificate (applicable only for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
- OBC Declaration form (applicable only to OBC candidates)
- Attested copy of Discharge Certificate in the case of Ex-Servicemen candidates.
- Photographs (one pasted on the application form & one additionally to be attached).

16. CANDIDATES MAY KINDLY NOTE

- 16.1 The candidates should have the requisite academic qualification from a recognized University/Institution with proof at the time of application and age as per Column No.12 mentioned against the post.
- 16.2 Ladies are also eligible. All vacancies will involve duties, which are arduous in nature and call for working in shifts at odd hours.
- 16.3 A CANDIDATE SHALL APPLY AGAINST VACANCIES OF ONE RRB ONLY FOR A PARTICULAR CATEGORY OF POST. Applying for more than one RRB for the same post is not allowed.

- 16.8 Candidates should send their application sufficiently in advance before the closing date. RRB will not be responsible for any postal delay/wrong delivery at any stage of the selection process.
- 16.9 All candidates irrespective of community will be considered for UR vacancy. However, against specific community quota, only candidates belonging to that community will be considered. Please note:

- Caste Certificate from competent authority for SC/ST and OBC candidates in the prescribed format have to be produced. OBC caste certificate should be current.
 - If the candidate wishes to be considered against a specific community quota and tick the community column accordingly, their application form will be rejected unless proof of community in the prescribed format is enclosed.

- Unsigned or/and undated applications or writing name in Capitals/open letters under signature column.
- Without the latest and clear photograph pasted on the application form.
- Applications without signatures
- Applications without two clear identification marks.
- Applications without clear Lefthand Thumb Impression.
- Applications without the declaration paragraph (Item No.10 of Information Sheet) in running handwriting.
- Applications of under aged or over aged candidates.
- Applications without the requisite Demand Drafts or Indian Postal orders or purchased before the date of employment notice or after the last date or value less than the prescribed (applicable only to UR and OBC candidates).
- Applications without proper Caste Certificate in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- Applications without the creamy layer certificate and/or declaration (applicable only to OBC candidates).
- Photocopies of caste certificates not attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- Applications received after the closing date and time.

19. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

If there is any change in the address, candidates should ensure in his/her own interest to arrange with the post office concerned for re-direction of the communication from old to new address.

20. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY

- 20.1 Action, as deemed necessary, will be taken by the RRB concerned against candidates found guilty of the following at the time of written test or at any subsequent stage:-
- Submitting fabricated/forged certificates or documents which have been tampered for getting selected or availing of free travel facilities, or
 - Using unfair means during the test, or
 - Impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person, or
 - Misbehaving in the examination hall or taking away the question or answer sheet from the examination hall, or
 - Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his candidature for the selection, or
 - Obtaining support/help for his candidature by any other means
- 20.2 Such candidates may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, shall also be liable for being:-
- disqualified from the test for which he/she is a candidate and/or
 - debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any test or selection held by any of the Railway Recruitment Boards.
- 20.3 Any such action taken by the RRB concerned will be final and binding on the candidate.

21. RRB'S DECISION IS FINAL

The decision of the RRB concerned in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, penalty for false information, mode of selection, allotment of examination centres, conduct of examination and interview, selection, allotment of post to selected candidates etc., will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained by the RRBs in this connection.

22. LEGAL

Any legal issues arising out of this Employment Notice, the jurisdiction shall be the administrative Bench of the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal applicable to concerned RRB to whom the application was made.
