### DATE OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR CATEGORY NO. 7 POST: TICKET COLLECTOR (FOR SC COMMUNITY CANDIDATES)

The first phase of written examination for Cat. No. 07, Post: Ticket Collector, against Employment Notice No. RRB/J-S/CDG/JEN-01/2006 dated 28-01-06 of RRB/J-S/Jammu for all the candidates belonging to schedule tribe community was held on 08.06.08. The second phase of written examination for **the above category/post & against above notification for Schedule Caste community candidates** is planned to be held on **19.10.08 simultaneously at Jammu and Chandigarh**. No candidate from ST community shall be allowed to appear in this examination as examination for ST candidates had already been held on 08.06.08. The SC community candidates who had appeared in examination dated 08.06.08, due to any of the reason, their candidature for that examination has been cancelled. Such candidates may therefore appear in this examination dated 19.10.08. The details of written examination are given as under :-

\* The examination centres to the candidates have been allotted as per following criteria :

Examination Centers	Criteria for allotment of examination centres
Jammu City	For all the candidates who are born after 01.01.1984 (including 01.01.1984). For all the candidates belonging to J&K State irrespective of their date of birth.
Chandigarh City	For all the candidates who are born before 31.12.1983 (including 31.12.1983).

Call-Letters to prima-facie eligible candidates are being despatched through U.P.C. The rejection advice has also been issued to ineligible candidates.

Those candidates who do not get Call-Letters may contact RRB Jammu Office (For those candidates whose centre is at Jammu) in person on date(s) and time mentioned above alongwith their original Educational/Technical qualifications certificates, two passport size recent photographs and original caste certificate to obtain duplicate Call-Letters. The Candidates whose examination centre is at Chandigarh may contact RRB/Chandigarh Office ( S.C.O-78-79, Sector-7, Madhya Marg, Chandigarh) for issue of duplicate call letters or for its correction. **In case there is any discrepancy in Call-Letters i.e. Name, Photograph, Category, Post etc. the candidates should approach the office of the RRB on above mentioned date(s) and time alongwith two passport size photographs for correction of Call-Letter. While every precautions is being taken to issue correct call letters however candidates are advised to see the correctness of the call letter vis-à-vis his application and get it corrected in case of discrepancy as it has bearing on the outcome of result. If a candidate fails to point out the discrepancies and get it rectified then it shall be sole responsibility of candidate if subsequently he becomes ineligible due to in-correctness of the call letter or he is not allowed to appear in the examination. If a candidate, whose application has been rejected, considers that his/her application has been wrongly rejected may come to this office in person with relevant documents/proof on dates and time (as mentioned above for issue of duplicate call letters) for considerations. If he is found eligible based on the documents produced by him, he will be issued call letter accordingly.**

Request for duplicate call letter or any correction will **NOT** be entertained on the day of the written examination i.e. on **19.10.2008** (Sunday). **It may be noted that duplicate Call-Letter will be issued only to those candidates whose names exist on Master List.**
